Instructions for the Preparation of Papers for the Proceedings of IZS 2008

Abstract—Instructions are given for the preparation and submission of the papers accepted for IZS 2008.

I. INTRODUCTION

Authors of accepted papers will be asked to produce a final manuscript not exceeding 4 pages that will be published in the Proceedings. Only electronic submissions in form of an IEEE Xplore-compatible PDF file will be accepted.

II. PREPARATION OF THE PAPER

Most authors will prepare their papers with LaTeX [1], [2], [3], [4]. You may download the LaTeX style file, a sample LaTeX file (this file), and the corresponding PDF file from the IZS 2008 web site (see below).

Users of other text processing systems should attempt to duplicate the style of this example, in particular the sizes and type of font, as closely as possible. The allowed typing area is 182 mm (7.15 in) by 235 mm (9.25 in). The left margin should be 14 mm for A4 (210 mm \times 297 mm) paper and 0.68 in for US Letter (8.5 in \times 11 in) paper. The top margin should be 30 mm for A4 paper and 0.75 in for US Letter paper. (However, as the top margins of electronic papers are notoriously difficult to control, we are prepared to correct the vertical margins.)

The use of Microsoft Word is not encouraged. However, acceptable formatting may be achieved by using the template available from the IZS web site.

The style of references, equations, figures, tables, etc., should be the same as for the *IEEE Transactions on Communications*. Pages should not be numbered. The affiliation shown for authors should constitute a sufficient mailing address for persons who wish to write for more details about the paper.

III. How to Submit

The submitted PDF files must comply with the standards of IEEE Xplore. Further information on this, and on how to submit the final PDF file, may be found at the IZS 2008 web site:

IV. IEEE COPYRIGHT FORM
